NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Community Development Block Grant Program

The City of Newport is considering the filing of an application for a Rhode Island Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). A maximum of \$500,000 is available to undertake the following range of activities:

- a) Improved housing opportunities for low and moderate income families and individuals.
- b) Provision of employment opportunities for low and moderate income persons.
- c) Provision of community facilities and services principally benefiting low and moderate income families and individuals.

A Public Hearing will be held at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 7, 2012 in the Newport City Hall, City Council Chambers (2nd Floor), 43 Broadway, Newport, Rhode Island for the purpose of obtaining the views of citizens on community development and housing needs and on program performance.
